

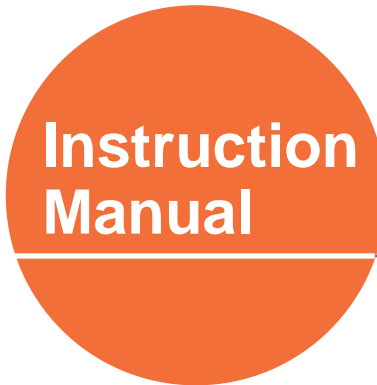

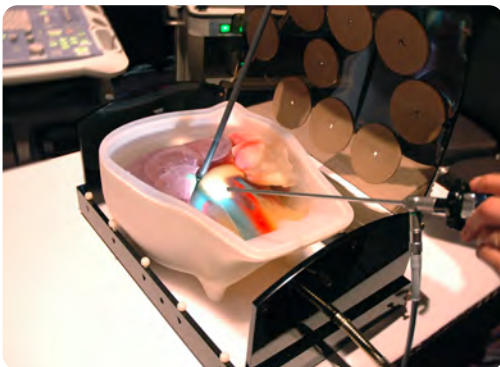

● Features

Soft materials of phantom organs allow realistic probe manipulation.

Near real-size organs, structures and abnormal lesions with approximate-to-human echogenicities.

Detailed hepatobiliary, pancreatic and other abdominal anatomy meeting requirement for excellent training: open intraoperative scanning and laparoscopic examination.

Various simulated lesions including biliary stones and cysts, solid tumors.

Detachable stomach and duodenum allows various scanning methods of the bile duct and pancreas.

Container allows water-immersion scanning for both contact and stand-off techniques, simulating real abdominal intraoperative and laparoscopic scanning.

Container with phantom fits in the laparoscopic trainer box so that laparoscopic ultrasound of organs is possible under direct laparoscopic view.

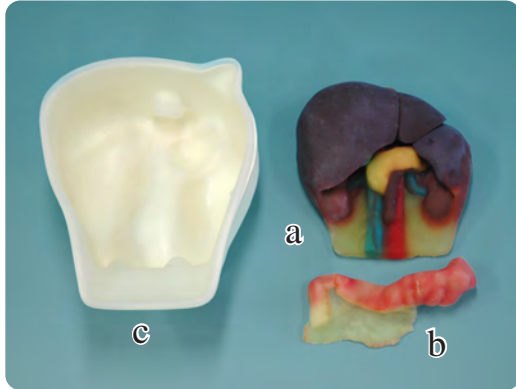

Before your first use, please ensure that you have all components listed below.



- a. Upper abdomen ultrasound phantom 1
the liver (segmental anatomy, portal and hepatic venous systems, ligamentum teres and ligamentum venosum), biliary tract (gallbladder, cystic duct, intrahepatic and extrahepatic bile ducts), pancreas (pancreatic duct), spleen, kidneys, detailed vascular structures (aorta, vena cava, celiac artery and its branches, portal vein and its branches, superior mesenteric vessels, renal vessels, etc)
- b. Stomach-duodenum phantom 1
- c. Phantom container 1
(a set of outer and inner container)

⚠ DOs and DON'T s

DO s

Handle with care.
The materials used for the phantom are made of special soft resin composites.
Excessive force may cause breakage.
Set the phantom properly as instructed below.
The phantom may float a little because its gravity is smaller than water.
Drain and dry before storage
After use, wipe the phantom and container with soft cloth or paper before storage.
Keep the training set at room temperature, away from heat, moisture and direct sunlight.

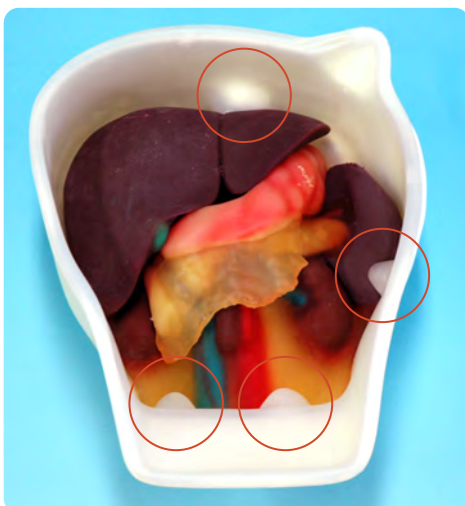
DON'Ts

Do not make puncture or incision
IOUSFAN is designed for ultrasound scanning only.
Do not try to make any puncture or incision as this will break the phantom.

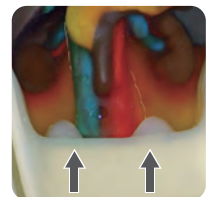
Never wipe the phantom or models with thinner or organic solvent.

Don't mark on the phantom with pen or leave printed materials contacted on their surface. Ink marks on the models will be irremovable.

1 Set-up



- ① Place the phantom in the container orientating it in spine position.
Fix it so that the four projections on the container wall hold the phantom in place.



- ② Fill the container with water until the phantom is fully covered.
The phantom may float a little in the water.

Now IOUSFAN is ready for training.

② Training items and simulated targets

Open intraoperative scanning of liver, biliary tract and pancreas.
Laparoscopic examination of the biliary system for screening of stones and evaluation of hepatic and pancreatic lesions, etc.

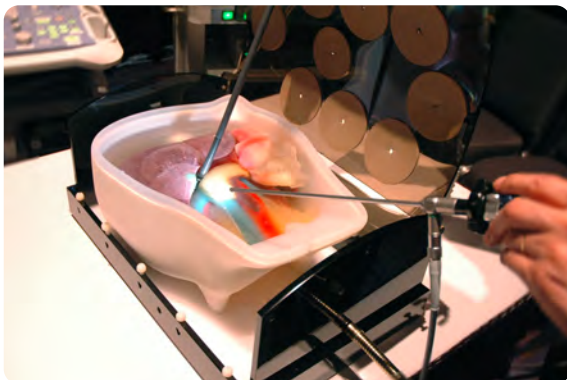


Open intraoperative scanning.

③ After use



① Drain water from the container.



② Wipe the container walls and the phantom by soft cloth and make them dry before storage.

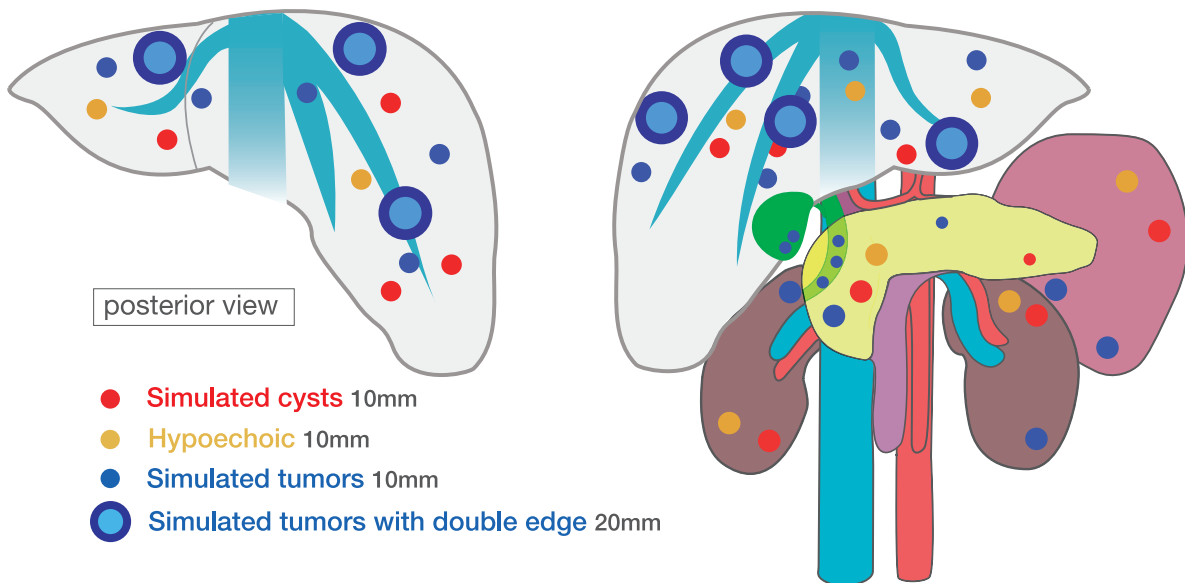
